## Innovation Centers on Inputs for Animal Nutrition and Health Network - RCIISNA: actions to create an idea network

Innovation Centers on Inputs for Animal Nutrition and Health Network - RCIISNA is linked to the Brazilian Technology System from the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation. In this context, is considered critical to stimulate the Brazilian enterprises and ICTs to cooperate for innovation.
